Conjunctions are joining words, They are also known as connecting words. They join words or group of words or short sentences.

The two conjunctions are - 'and' and 'but'.

'And'

(I) We use 'and' to combine similar ideas.

Examples are —

(a) John loves to play cricket.

John loves to play ludo.

→ John loves to play cricket and ludo

(b) Dog is a faithful animal.

Dog is a clever animal.

→ Dog is a faithful and clever animal.

(c) This Monday is a holiday. I would like to go for a picnic.

→ This Monday is a holiday and I would like to go for a picnic.

(II) We use and to join two nouns.
For eg, - (See Pg No. 61).

(III) We use and to join two adjectives.
For eg - (See Pg 61).

(IV) We use and to join two adverbs.

Grammar book - Pg 61).
