Ch II. Conjunctions

Read

'But'

We use the conjunction but when we join two ideas which are different or opposite in meaning.

Examples :-

- ① It was bright. It was cold.
→ It was bright but cold.
- ② Aryan wants to play. He is sick.
→ Aryan wants to play but he is sick.
- ③ Elephant is big. Cat is small.
→ Elephant is big but cat is small.
- ④ Roses are red. Jasmine are white.
→ Roses are red but Jasmine are white.

Few more examples are -

- ① Sheela is tall. Mala is short.
→ Sheela is tall but Mala is short.
- ② Sunil is fat. Anil is thin.
→ Sunil is fat but Anil is thin.
